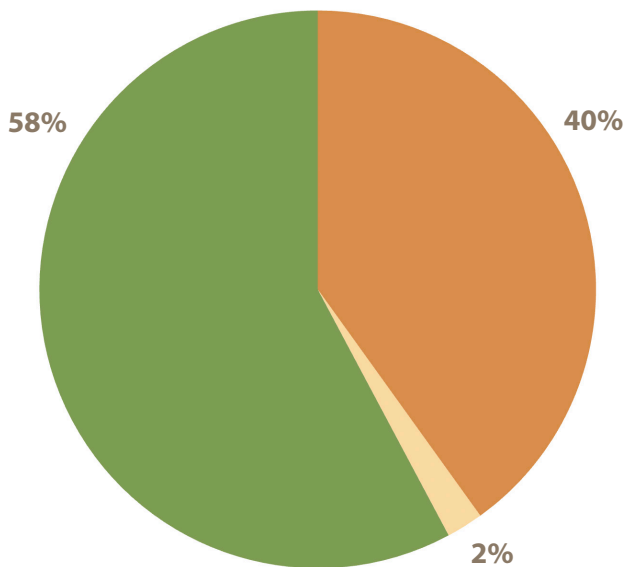
## TOTAL EXPENSE
