Eggs and an assortment of produce are available.

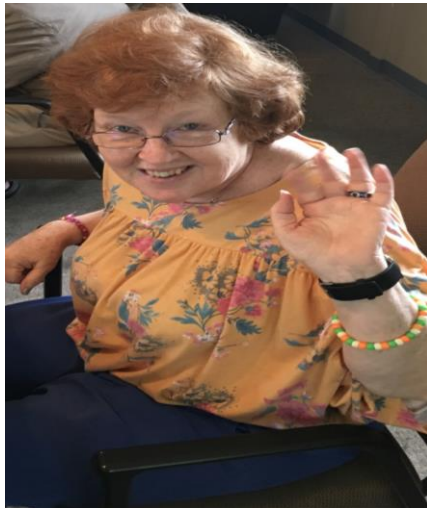
