Effective beginning on Wednesday, March 18, 2020, Joy's House Adult Day and Caregiver Support Services in Broad Ripple and the University of Indianapolis are temporarily suspending operations due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Our top priority is always the safety and care of our Guests (clients) and we will do everything in our power to provide the most responsible and secure setting in which to serve our seniors and/or those affected by a life-altering diagnosis. Since we serve one of the most vulnerable populations susceptible to this novel coronavirus, we will temporarily suspend services at our houses (facilities) in order to protect them, their family caregivers, and our staff from possible exposure. We are proactively doing this now as we do our part to slow down and stop the spread of this disease.
