Adult Day Services

The challenges our Guests (clients) face do not define who they are while at Joy's House. We acknowledge personal needs and limitations but focus even more on each person's interests, hobbies and skills. Your loved one will be warmly welcomed into our family.

Who visits as a Guest?

We host Guests seeking safety, companionship and engagement in the community. Many of our Guests are no longer able to stay at home alone safely due to basic aging or a variety of diagnoses, including but not limited to, dementia, autism, Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis and Down syndrome.

What are admission requirements for Guests?

Joy's House is a non-medical adult day service for Guests who are 18 and older. Every Guest goes through an assessment to make sure that our services are a good fit.

What are our hours and rates for Guest services?

Monday - Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Broad Ripple location: \$75/day UIndy location: \$70/day *This includes a morning snack, lunch and an afternoon snack, and activity costs.*

We accept Aged and Disabled (A&D) Medicaid Waiver and CHOICE. Financial assistance is available through our Guest Scholarship Program.
